


#### **Minority Outreach Survey Results**

Our electronic media outreach encompasses both promotional efforts and survey/data collection. Though paper surveys were collected, our data was compiled using the online data management services of Survey Monkey. Our survey consisted of 29 questions, addressing the areas of demographics, attitudes about death and dying, and knowledge of hospice services. The survey administered during Phase I of this study garnered a total of 349 responses nationwide. Eighty of those responses were from Clark County. Of the total 349 respondents, 250 were African American. Fifty-one of the African American responses were from Clark County, Arkansas.

### Q1 What is your age?




### Q2 How do you identify your gender?


### Q3 Which race/ethnicity best describes you? (Please choose only one.)

### Q4 What is your current marital status?






## Q8 How often do you attend religious or spiritual services?

#### Q9 How often do you find strength in your religion or spirituality?











# Q18 Which of these health problems do you think are worse than death? (Choose all that apply.)





### Q20 At the end of my life, I expect to need someone to...











# Q24 If so, how did you hear about hospice services? (Choose all that apply.)




### Q25 If you were dying, would you want hospice services?


# Q26 If so, where would you want to receive hospice services? (Choose all that apply.)


# Q27 To the best of your knowledge, does Medicare pay for hospice services?






