## Medical Director Hospice Services

Dr. Wyatt joined Arkansas Hospice in December 2006. He has served in many leadership roles at the organization, including vice president and chief medical officer, and he was instrumental in the 2015 launch of Arkansas Palliative Care. Wyatt served as Associate Medical Director from July 2020 to November 2024 when he was named Medical Director, Hospice Services.

Wyatt graduated as a doctor of osteopathic medicine at the Oklahoma State University Center for Health Sciences College of Osteopathic Medicine, and he completed his internship and residency in Tulsa. In February, 2025, he earned the designation Fellow of the American Academy of Hospice and Palliative Medicine (FAAHPM).

Dr. Wyatt serves on the faculty of the Arkansas College of Osteopathic Medicine, the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Medicine, and the New York Institute of Technology College of Osteopathic Medicine located on the campus of Arkansas State University in Jonesboro. He is the lead physician for Arkansas Hospice's inpatient palliative care consult service at Unity Health in Searcy and is an adjunct teaching physician for the hospital's five Graduate Medical Education programs.
